Northminster Presbyterian Student Ministry Brief Adult Leader Job Description

“An adult volunteer is an adult of at least 19 years of age and is a Christian committed to loving Jesus and loving others through personal and authentic friendships and by demonstrating Christian leadership and Character.”

In addition, an adult leader is expected to:

1. be intentional in their relationships with youth.
2. be a member of Northminster Presbyterian or someone with a Young Life, Youth for Christ, or strong student ministry background.
3. submit to a background check
4. be in regular attendance to student ministry events, leadership meetings, and training times.
5. do contact work
6. have a mature view of tobacco and alcohol
7. adhere to Biblical guidelines of sexual behavior
8. complete new leaders training
9. obey the “laws of the land”
10. be a “team” player
11. have “serious fun”

Many of these expectations will be outlined in an interview with the director of student ministries or a senior team leader. They will also be further explained in your student ministry training times.
